- Summary Statement

Experiences must be scheduled and occur already between January 6 to May 8, 2020

3. Applications should be submitted on paper using 12-point standard font, double-spaced, and may not exceed two typed one-sided pages. Research, visual, and/or monetary documentation and information can be included on following pages. ***Please do not use school, mascot, teacher, or principal names in the text of the application.***
4. Proposals will be considered if they meet the following requirements:
 - a. The project/experience must be scheduled and occur already between January 6 to May 8, 2020.
 - b. The project should include engaging and creative experiential learning activities linked to integrated curriculum standards and learning outcomes.
 - c. Appropriate use of funds includes purchase of project materials, admission costs and/or transportation.
 - d. Examples may be experiential assemblies that actively engage students in curriculum, such as day field trips or events brought to the site.
 - e. Student work/projects, should be part of the evaluation of the experience and samples submitted to the ABC Education Foundation along with an itemized budget showing use of funds by May 8, 2020.
5. Apply as individual teachers, teams, grade levels/departments, or schools. All persons listed on the application should be collaborators in the process.
6. The Foundation reserves the right to offer partial funding.
